## **BERMUDA TURF PROGRAM**

ROUND ONE: February 15<sup>th</sup> – March 15<sup>th</sup> RATES (may vary)

0-0-7 w/ .426% Barricade 10,000 sq ft/bag

-Water in for best results.

If noticeable broadleaf weeds have already emerged -

SPOT SPRAY WITH Weed Free Zone, Trimec, Escalade or T-Zone see label

ROUND TWO: 4 weeks after round 1

19-0-6 w/ .15% Dimension 25%scu 13,000 sq ft/bag

-Water in for best results.

If noticeable broadleaf weeds remain -

SPOT SPRAY WITH Weed Free Zone, Trimec, Escalade or T-Zone see label

ROUND THREE: Late May & ONLY if pre-emergent has not been applied

Aerate to promote growth & apply

18-20-3 25% xcu 12,500 sq ft/bag

This is also a great time to seed with Bermuda seed (only if PRE-EMERGENT was not applied in rounds 1 or 2)!!!

ROUND FOUR: Apply at the beginning of each month (JUNE/JULY/AUGUST)

32-0-8 30% xcu w/2% Iron 16,000 sq ft/bag

-If you seeded at the end of May do not apply the June application of Round 4.

If noticeable grassy weeds appear -

SPOT SPRAY WITH Sedge Hammer, Dismiss, Q4, or Drive see label

-Do not spray selective herbicides in the heat of the day!

-Sedge Hammer & Dismiss only control nut grass.

-Q4 & Drive control crabgrass, dallisgrass and goosegrass.

-Do not spray any selective herbicides on newly established Bermuda seed!

ROUND FIVE: September – October 31st

18-20-3 25% xcu 12,500 sq ft/bag

Overseed w/ Perennial Rye seed 6lbs per 1000 sq ft min

8lbs per 1000 sq ft max

ROUND SIX: 6 weeks after Round 5

32-0-8 30% xcu w/2% Iron 16,000 sq ft/bag

-Do not apply this round if you did not seed instead repeat Round 1.
